RULES

- 1) Remember, this a fundraising tournament to support the AGCMO Education Foundation which provides financial scholarships to students interested in working in the construction industry. Each year the AGCMO Education Foundation provides monetary scholarships to students that might be attending a four-year college, technical trade school or an apprenticeship. Please relax and have fun!
- 2) Registrants must obey all Missouri Department of Conservation rules.
- 3) The minimum length limit on crappie on Lake of the Ozarks is 9 inches.
- 4) Life vests must be worn at take off and when boats are on plane.
- 5) Both artificial and live bait are allowed.
- 6) Crappie must be hooked and landed with a rod and reel by team member(s). All fish must be taken from tournament waters.
- 7) Tournament waters is defined as anywhere on Lake of the Ozarks. No fishing allowed off bank or boat dock.
- 8) Only seven (7) fish may be presented for weighing. All fish must be alive. Team is allowed to select one (1) crappie for optional biggest crappie award.
- 9) Eight (8) rods rigged with no more than two hooks maximum, fished at any one time per team.
