Chapter of the Year, James E. Cashman and J. Howard Mock Awards

Chapter of the Year Award entries are due on **January 29, 2010**.

Awards will be presented at the 91st AGC of America Annual Convention in Orlando, Florida, March 17-20, 2010.

Chapter of the Year, Chapter President of the Year and Chapter Executive of the Year will now have two categories (**Large** and **Small**) of eligibility based on the annual budget of the Chapter.

The James E. Cashman Trophy: This award is for the most effective membership growth program. Part I requires the Chapter to write a brief narrative describing membership growth activities. The national office will complete Part II based on AGC of America's membership records (as of January 30, 2010).

J. Howard Mock Award: All Chapters automatically compete for this award for the best overall net growth in membership. No award application is necessary. AGC of America's membership records are used (as of January 30, 2010) to determine the winner.
