An updated 2010 Dues spreadsheet will be emailed to Chapters shortly.

As a reminder, the following are some procedures of special note:

- Please be advised that members that were not dropped during the initial membership dues reporting due in April are still carried as “live” members in our database and chapters will still be held responsible for their full 2010 dues payment.

- No new members will be added “live” to our database and/or membership counts without full payment. Please include a check with all new membership applications.

- Proration of Dues – Dues received for members who join between January 1 and June 30 should be submitted in full. If a member joins your chapter between July 1 and December 31, you may submit 50 percent of the regularly scheduled dues amount.

- Refunds – No refunds for dues will be issued once payment has been received.
